

Annual Report on the Proceedings of the PCC 2021-22

PCC Meetings

This has been yet another unusual year for the PCC, with the majority of the 7 meetings taking place using Zoom. In fact, the first time the PCC met “in person” was for the Archdeacon’s Visitation in September 2021. We welcomed several new members onto the PCC following last year’s APCM, namely - Lowri Banfield, Tracy Jenkins, Sue Saull, Louise Sear, Lekisha Atkinson and Allison Paing.

Clair Reilly and Richard Berndes, having served 2 terms of 3 years, stood down as PCC members in April 2022.

We appointed Laura Bruce as Treasurer, Claire Reilly was appointed as Additional Needs Officer, Tracy Jenkins was appointed Safeguarding Officer and Dinos Kousoulou as Secretary.

The budget for 2022 was approved and the PCC received update reports on the Restoration Project.

Living in Love and Faith

The PCC agreed that a small working group led by Barry Snelgrove should be established to explore the possibility of introducing this Diocesan initiative into Church. The Group presented its final report to the PCC in April 2022 with a recommendation that St Andrew’s should pursue the introduction of this initiative.

Archdeacon’s Visitation

The PCC welcomed the Archdeacon of Hampstead to its meeting on the 7 September. This was an opportunity for the Archdeacon to meet with the PCC without Rev Dr Steve Griffiths being present, to enable the Archdeacon to explore how well the various functions of the Church’s administration are being managed. The Archdeacon produced a report of his visit including conclusions and recommendations. This is available on the website.

Nominations to the Old Enfield Charitable Trust

St Andrew’s has long nominated 2 Trustees onto the Trust. In the past these Trustees were nominated by the Priest, however, it was agreed by the PCC that in future, nominations will rest with the PCC.

There are a number of other substantive issues covered by the PCC during this term of office which will be covered by separate reports.
